

Fishing Cat Toy

Sock, Twine, T-shirt scraps, Optional: stick

Push t-shirt scraps into the toe of the sock. Shape the toe of the sock so that it resembles a fish. For longer socks, you can tie a knot in the sock to keep the stuffing in place. (Hint: If the end of the sock is too long, cut off the end to make a shorter tail for the fish.) Next, tie the twine around the knot in the sock, leaving a long end so that you can dangle the fish and make it wiggle around so that your cat chases it! For shorter socks, tie the twine around the sock, to hold the stuffing in place. Make sure and leave a long enough end on the twine so that you can use it to dangle the fish and make it wiggle.
