

Mendon Public Library - Code of Conduct



The safety and security of people and library property is of the utmost importance. The library also strives to maintain a clean, comfortable, and welcoming environment. We ask that patrons help us by following the rules in this Code of Conduct.

1. Harassing, aggressive, and/or intimidating language and actions are prohibited.
 2. Disruptive behavior is prohibited.
 3. Disrespecting others' space and privacy is prohibited.
 4. Weapons, intoxicating substances, and anything illegal and/or unsafe are prohibited.
 5. Caregivers must supervise the people in their care.
 6. Solicitation is prohibited.
 7. Leave all areas, materials, and equipment clean and tidy as you found them.
 8. Do not leave personal items unattended.
- The judgment of the Library Director or other staff in charge shall prevail should it become necessary to confront a patron regarding the Code of Conduct.
 - Should a request to modify objectionable behavior not be complied with, patrons may be asked to leave the library premises.
 - Law enforcement authorities may be called if a person who is instructed to leave does not comply.
 - If severe or repeated violations of the Code of Conduct occur, the Library Director, acting on behalf of the Board of Trustees, may suspend an individual's library privileges.
 - Any person whose library privileges are suspended shall be advised in writing of the suspension and the reason(s) for such action. The offending person shall also be informed that the suspension may be appealed at the next regularly scheduled Library Board meeting.
