



Week Seven: The Living Environment!

Kid Craft/Make a Sea Porthole

Materials Provided: 2 paper plates, stickers, pipe cleaners

Additional Materials Needed: paint or coloring material, glue or tape, any extra sea decorations you'd like

Cut out the center of one of the paper plates. Flip this plate over (it should be convex) and color or paint the outside rim of this plate to form your porthole. On your second plate, color or paint the inside circle whatever color you would like the sea to be. Decorate this inner circle to create your seascape; you can use the provided stickers and pipe cleaners to add sea life and coral. You can also use any additional materials from home that you think belong "under the sea". Glue or tape the porthole plate to the sea plate and you have your 3D porthole window.
