



**Week Seven: Living Environment!  
Teen & Adult Craft/Make a Bird Feeder**

Materials Provided: tray, yarn, birdseed

Additional Materials Needed: tin foil, peanut butter

Cover your tray with tin foil, then make three holes in the tray/tinfoil in a triangle pattern so that it will hang evenly. Cut your yarn into 3 equal pieces. Tie a piece around each of the 3 holes and then tie them together at the top to form your hanger. Be sure the raised sides of the tray are on top! Smear a thin coat of peanut butter on the foil and sprinkle on your seeds. Be sure to hang your feeder high enough so predators won't disturb the birds while they are eating.
