So far this year, FMPL have supported the Summer Reading Program and much more! FMPL help provide free, inclusive programming for all members of our community throughout the year. They fund our popular Take & Make Crafts, offer supplies for youth activities, and fund new and engaging toys in our Children's area, and ongoing care for everyone's favorite library fish, Clementine.

FMPL accomplished all this by conducting a variety of fundraisers, including their Annual Appeal, Red Library Bag Sales, Spring Flower Sale, Historic Brick Sale (just like the one inscribed for Nancy), In-Library Used Book Sale, online donations, and ROC the Day participation.
